Shueh-li Ong is a Nashville-based songwriter, composer, producer, synthesist, and world-renown thereminist. The theremin is played without contact but with precision finger movements in the air and acute hearing.

Shueh-li is a multi-instrumentalist who also plays the synthesizer, tin-whistle and sings, alongside her proximity instrument that was customized by American synth innovator, Bob Moog. Her music blends elements of her training in classical and electronic music, and her Australian-Singaporean heritage.

Shueh-li has produced 4 albums to date. Her theremin playing also features on projects by other artists and producers. These include the album *La Conquista Del Espacio* by Fito Páez (the album won the 2020 Latin Grammy and 2021 American Grammy awards), an indie sci-fi film, contemporary classical and theatrical productions, and several prog-rock albums.

Shueh-li was crowned Nashville's "Queen" of the theremin by the SCENE magazine. She was also named "Diva" of the theremin by both the Singapore Straits Times newspaper and A-List magazine.
